Mallorca and Puerto Vallarta were her favorite and most romantic. LLANA is English and Catalonia Spanish but never learned the language. In
Mallorca, she enjoyed listening to the Irish culture brogue.

This same friend also taught her to love history. She likes to read about European history and other historical books. The History TV channel feeds her thirst for more knowledge and provides information about ancient aliens, another topic of which she is curious.

When she does have time to watch TV, she prefers old movies. We both sighed remembering the romantic movies Casablanca, Out of Africa and The English Patient. A favorite sitcom was Two and A Half Men which she considered very clever.
